Randal Collins McClendon, 48, died unexpectedly on February 9, 2022, in Sacramento, following a lengthy illness and hospitalization. His funeral service will be held at St. Robert Catholic Church in Sacramento, on Saturday, February 26, 2022, at 11:00 a.m., followed by a luncheon at Maggie's Table at Casa Garden.

Randy was born in Sacramento on March 26, 1973, to Rick McClendon and Kathleen Wykoff. During his childhood, he lived in Loomis, Crescent City, and Wheatland. He graduated from Wheatland High School in 1991. From there, he attended Yuba College where he earned admission to the prestigious University of Virginia. After receiving his bachelor's degree in 1995, he attended McGeorge School of Law, graduating in 1998.
